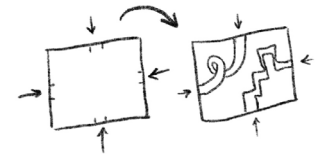


A GREEN PLACE TO BE

PARK MAP MOSAIC ACTIVITY

In *A Green Place to Be* we saw Frederick Law Olmsted and Calvert Vaux work together to create Central Park, and each contributed their own unique elements. What would you put in if you were making a park?

- 1 **Make a path!** Draw your own park paths by connecting the path edge lines at the sides of the page. Your paths can be any shape that you like.



- 2 **What's in your park?** Draw in anything that you would want to find in your own park. Do you have a carousel? A skating pond? A meadow? A dinosaur paddock? A secret castle?



- 3 **Free your park piece and add it to the park grid.** Cut along dotted line to free your piece of the park from the page, and then add it to the park grid to see how it connects with everyone else.
