


PARK MAP MOSAIC ACTIVITY

In A Green Place to Be we saw Frederick Law Olmsted and Calvert Vaux work together to create Central Park, and each contributed their own unique elements. What would you put in if you were making a park?

1 Make a path! Draw your own park paths by connecting the path edge lines at the sides of the page. Your paths can be any shape that you like.



2 What's in your park? Draw in anything that you would want to find in your own park. Do you have a carousel? A skating pond? A meadow? A dinosaur paddock? A secret castle?



3 Free your park piece and add it to the park grid. Cut along dotted line to free your piece of the park from the page, and then add it to the park grid to see how it connects with everyone else.
